# **Observations and General Discussion (Solar and Lunar)**

- Drew M: Potential Locations for Solar Eclipse in August 2017:
  - o Showed a map with the path through the US for full umbra
  - Charleston has 72% chance of rain in August
  - Weather forecast for the East Coast shows high probability of rain
  - Eastern side of Cascades have best weather forecast.
  - Salem and Madras Oregon have the best weather and location
  - Casper Wyoming is OK
- Recommendation for WAS members interested in viewing the Solar Eclipse:
  - Called Madras, Oregon all hotels already booked
  - WAS sponsored stay is in Prineville , Oregon.
  - Will be part of event sponsored by local astronomy club.

- April 8 2024 have another solar eclipse
- Solar Eclipse Predictions for Philadelphia in 2024 has 88% blocked. Toronto is 97%
- Alan D: Discussed Lunar orbital dynamics
- Bernie K: Showed Lunar pictures (Tyco, Clavius, Copernicus, Gassendi, and Rilles)
- Jerry L: Showed pictures of the moon, lunar X, the moon and the Pleiades, occultation of the
  moon with Chi Taurus, a Lunar transit, an ISS transit, Clavius, Aristarcus, Copernicus, the phases
  of a total Lunar eclipse, HDR image of a thin crest moon, a crescent moon over Philadelphia
  (APOD), HDR sunset, sun spots, a solar flare in Halpha, a Solar prominence, the Mercury transit
  in 1989, a ISS solar transit, the 2004 Venus transit, and an Annular total eclipse,
